GOIF

GRAND ORIENT OF ITALY FEDERAL - The Italian Masonic Renaissance in the third millennium -

The very first appearance of Speculative Freemasonry in the Italian territory dates back on the XVIIIth century, with the presence of sovereign, individual Masonic Lodges:

- South in Sicilia, Calabria and Campania.
- Centre in Lazio, Umbria and Toscana (where in the first half of 1700 dies in Florence the first martyr of Italian Freemasonry Bro:. Tommaso Crudeli).
- North in Liguria, Piemonte and Lombardia.

Having been Freemasonry hardly thwarted and fought by the Roman Catholic Church and governative powers, it was even strongly affected by internal conflictuality and, by the end of XVIIIth century, and the outline of Italian Freemasonry featured several lodges following the Egyptian Rite in the South, Lodges of English and French Rite in the Centre and Symbolic Rite in the North.

Thanks to Bro:. Giuseppe Garibaldi, 1^{st} Grand Master of the Grand orient of Italy (GOI), Italian Freemasonry found unity and, during the Risorgimento it had its utmost Strength, Beauty and Wisdom, bringing an outstanding contribution, through men, ideas and determination to reach the intellectual and material Freedom in our Country.

In the XXth century (1908) the Italian Masonic Unity of GOI spitted apart, originating the so called Ferian Schism (by the name of the main protagonist Saverio Fera) due to the disputing point of view on the laicality and religiousness of Freemasonry; the came-out Brethrens set up the Grand Lodge of Piazza del Gesù, as from the address of its first premise in Piazza del Gesù, 47 in Rome.

During fascist regime (1930 – 1940), Freemasonry had been harshly banned and its Grand Master and Senior Officers made it non-operational taking refuge out of the country or sent to exile.

After the first half of XXth century, Freemasonry re-starts its activity , GOI is re-settled as well as the Grand Lodge of Piazza del Gesù, although further divisions take place with the formation of several Grand Lodges, each one claiming to be the legitimate derivation of the original Grand Lodge of Piazza del Gesù.

After an important though incomplete unification between GOI (Grand Master Bro:. Lino Salvini) and Grand Lodge of Piazza del Gesù (Grand Master Francesco Bellantonio) which took place in 1973 when GOI was recognised by the United Grand Lodge of England – UGLE, again a new division fell on the GOI in 1993.

Its Past Grand Master in fact, Giuliano Di Bernardo established the Regular Grand Lodge of Italy – GLRI and gathered several Lodges that worked before giving their allegiance to other Masonic Institutions. It was an important Masonic event, not for the numbers involved, but for the relevant recognition which UGLE gave it denying at the same time the one earlier given to GOI.

This flourishing of Grand Lodges and lack of organisation at the same time characterised the Italian Masonic scenario throughout the XXth Century.

The above is just a brief summary of the most relevant facts of the history Italian Freemasonry that, by the end of the XXth Century is mainly represented, as for the first three degrees (Apprentice, Fellow Craft, Master) of solar Masonry (men only) by:

- ➢ GOI
- ➢ GLRI
- ➤ Various Grand Lodges, mainly deriving from the Grand Lodge of Piazza del Gesù or from schism within GOI (like Grand Lodge of Italy of the Universal Masonry of Palazzo Giustiniani GLDI della MU da PG, established in 1978 by Vittorio Colao, Pierangelo Mininnj, Giovanni Pica and others).

Why GOIF - Italian Masonic Renaissance in the third millennium?

Whereas

The above described Masonic Panorama has been strongly affected by situations outside Masonic Traditions and was led by spurious -fake-Masonic deviations.

Whereas

There is a heart-felt necessity to go back to the Beauty of Initiation, the inner research of Man, the intellectual and spiritual achievements through the study of symbolism, the application of esoteric knowledge for the conquest of the "pure" concept of Liberty, Equality and Fraternity.

Requiring

All Italian Brethren the "true" return to the Universal Masonic Tradition, because we all wish to make it "our own garden full of flowers and fountains of fresh and clear water of strength, virtue and harmony" where all of us, Masons, shall be able to drink deep from.

The answer

Is the establishment of GOIF – MHC of Italy, which works under the auspices of the MHCMW (*Masonic High Council Mother of the World*), a Grand Orient Federal of Italy made up of Grand Lodges and Grand Orients regularly working according to the initiatic regularity and old traditions (Landmarks).


GOIF is a regular and federal Masonic Obedience of the first three degrees that, in respect of the historical identity of its constituent Grand Lodges and/or Grand Orients, along with several Masonic Allegiances working under the auspices of the RGLE-MHCMW throughout the world, has endorsed Treaties such as the "Treaty of London" and the "Accord of Paris" that aim at fostering the development of the Universal Freemasonry of "true" traditions.

Outstanding efforts and work are being done by all GOIF Brethren in order to achieve a Masonic unity and the goal of joining together Initiates.

GOIF keeps a continuous contact and remain available for comparing it-self with others Masonic Obedience's, provided that they are respectful of the landmarks and in compliance with the Italian laws on Masonic associations, which might be willing to play a role as protagonist, in this venturing work of our:


